Sharon Krevor-Weisbaum Receives 2017 Leadership in Law Award

Sharon is one of Maryland's leading lawyers for individuals with disabilities, their families, and organizations that serve them. After serving for nine years as an Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Sharon has been a partner at Brown, Goldstein & Levy since 2001. As of January 2016, the firm chose Sharon as its Managing Partner.

Among Sharon's many achievements as an attorney, she has successfully represented university students with disabilities in Americans with Disabilities Act litigation to ensure that they have equal access to their curriculum and other services and successfully represented parents with disabilities in child protection proceedings and other family law matters. She also represents non-profit and for-profit community-based providers that support people with disabilities and represents health care practitioners before state disciplinary boards.

Sharon received the Attorney General's Pro Bono award for her work coordinating the Office's Pro Bono Program. The Arc of Baltimore recognized her with its Stanley S. Herr Advocacy Leadership Award, and The Arc of Maryland honored her with its Bernard A. Gould Award for Outstanding Leadership and Dedication Benefitting Persons with Developmental Disabilities and their Families. *The Daily Record* has twice included Sharon among the Top 100 Women in Maryland, and her peers voted her among Maryland Super Lawyers Top 50 Women.
