

## Brooke Lierman Has Been Selected For an Aspen Institute-Rodel Fellowship

We are proud to announce that Brooke Lierman, Of Counsel to Brown, Goldstein & Levy and Maryland State Delegate for District 46, has been selected for the 2017 Aspen Institute's Rodel Fellowships program.

The Aspen-Rodel Fellowship in Public Leadership is open by invitation only to men and women who serve in publicly elected office. Chosen on an annual basis, each Fellowship class consists of 24 Fellows: 12 Republicans and 12 Democrats, each an emerging political leader with a reputation for intellect, thoughtfulness, and a commitment to civil dialogue.



The Fellowships, established in 2005, work to enhance American democracy by convening the nation's most promising young political leaders in a casual, bipartisan setting to explore the underlying values and principles of western democracy, the relationship between individuals and their community, and the responsibilities of public leadership.

Brooke's practice includes workers' rights litigation, disability rights, §1983 litigation, commercial contract disputes, and Randolph-Sheppard Act cases involving blind vendors. Brooke is also part of a team representing blind students in their quest for accessible technology at colleges and universities.

In November 2014, Brooke was elected to her first term in the Maryland House of Delegates, representing District 46 (Baltimore City). She now serves in the General Assembly as a member of the Appropriations Committee.
